

## MLF Pool Rules - 2023

1. Only current Martin's Landing residents and recreational members in good standing may access the pools.
2. **ACCESS CARDS REQUIRED.** Pool gates must remain closed and locked at all times. Members must use keycards for access. Do not open the gate for individuals without keycards.
3. **LAP SWIM / SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY NO GUESTS.** All members under 16 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult member in good standing.
4. **GUARDED SWIM- LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.** All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a competent individual (i.e., a person 16 years or older with swimming proficiency).
5. **LIMIT 4 guests per household.**
6. All swimmers must exit the pool during safety break and allow lifeguards to perform safety check. After the safety check, members 16 and older may enter the pool. Any members under the age of 16 must remain entirely out of the pool during safety break. Babies in swim float devices supervised by a competent individual or babies being held by a competent individual (i.e, a person 16 years or older with swimming proficiency) may remain in the pool during Safety Breaks.
7. **NO UNAPPROVED PARTIES of 12 or more people.** \$100 fine assessed by the BOD for any unauthorized events/ and/or parties. The BOD has the right to suspend access to the pool based on recommendations from the pool committee. Parties involving 12 or more people REQUIRE AMS party approval two weeks prior to event/party.
8. **NO GLASS.** \$500 fine assessed by the BOD for any glass in the pool area in addition to costs associated with cleaning any broken glass.
9. **NO AFTER HOURS ENTRY.** The BOD has the right to suspend access to the pool based on recommendations from the pool committee.
10. Use emergency release button in case of emergency to evacuate the pool.
11. No pets permitted in the pool area. Service dogs are allowed on the deck.
12. Swim diapers must be worn by any child three years younger who is not potty-trained or any incontinent person.
13. Only children under 5 years of age are permitted in the Lake Pavilion wading pool.
14. Children utilizing a flotation aid must have an adult in the pool and within 5 feet of the child.

15. If a person defecates or vomits in the pool, notify lifeguard immediately or call AMS 770-932-6389. The pool will be closed for chemical treatment and cleaning as required. Cost of treating and cleaning the pool will be assessed against the owner responsible for the actions that led to the required treatment and cleaning (Fine \$250).
16. No eating or drinking in the pools. Keep food 10 feet away from the pools. All beverages must be 5 feet from the pools.
17. No smoking or vaping inside the fenced area of the pools.
18. No running or rough play in the pools or the decks around the pools.
19. No breath holding games.
20. No swimming in the diving area.
21. Dive blocks are for swim team use only.
22. Only one person at a time may be on the diving boards.
23. No double jumping on the diving boards.
24. Toys, rafts, and floats are allowed at the lifeguard's discretion.
25. No water guns.
26. No tennis, football or other hard balls allowed.
27. No bikes, skateboards, scooters, or other vehicles inside the pool area / pool deck.
28. **LIGHTNING/THUNDER.** All swimmers must exit the pool for a minimum of 30 minutes should a lifeguard detect lifeguard.
29. Do not disturb the lifeguard on duty. Lifeguard has the authority to enforce all ML rules. Violations will be assessed by the BOD.
30. Report injuries to lifeguard on duty.

## **Pool Reminders**

1. No solo swimming.
2. Shower before entering the water.
3. Children shall not use pool without a competent individual in attendance.
4. Do not swim if the suction outlets are missing, broken, or not clearly visible from the deck.
5. Do not swallow the pool water.
6. Do not dive unless diving area is clear of other swimmers.
7. Do not swim if you had diarrhea within the past two weeks.
